a Martha (oldest girl) and a Richard (5th & youngest boy). The 2nd & 3rd girls were called Mary & Elizabeth - both of which were sisters of Thomas (b.1761). The only flaw in this theory is that the 1st, 3rd & 4th boys were called George, William & John and these are not names which appear in the family of Thomas (b.1761), although they could be names from the Wilson family instead.

Thomas Ashton's last child was born in 1821, but after this nothing is known of him. If his burial can be traced, it may give an indication of his age and allow the above parentage to be proved.
