	LAST WILL & TESTAMENT (1737): In the Name of God Amen I ISAACK ASPLAND the Elder of Downham within the Isle of Ely and County of Cambridge, Thatcher, being of a sound and disposing mind and memory Do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following.
	I Give and Devise to my Son ISAACK ASPLAND his Heirs and Assigns for ever all that Messe and Tenement situate in Downham with the Buildings Garden and Yard thereunto belonging provided always nevertheless and upon condition that my said Son his Heirs and Assigns and every of them shall and will permit and suffer my loving Wife ELLEN ASPLAND and her assigns peacefully and quietly to have hold occupy possess and enjoy the said premises with all and singular the appurts aforesaid for and during and so long as she continues my Widow and to receive perceive and take Rents and Profits issuing out of the premises aforesaid for during the said Term without the let suit
	trouble Eviction or Ejection of my said Son his Heirs or Assigns or of any other Person claiming any Tithe from by or under them or any of them. And my Will and meaning is that in case my said Son his Heirs or Assigns or any of them shall hereafter disturb remove or expel my said Wife or her Assigns from her or their possession of the abovementioned premises or any part thereof or shall bring or commence any Suit or Action at Law against my said Wife or her Assigns for or by reason of her or their possession concerning the same that then and in such or cases my said Wife shall have and enjoy and I do hereby Give and Devise unto her all that Messe or Tenement aforesaid to have and to hold the same to her my said Wife for and during her natural life (she my said Wife keeping the said premises in Tenantable repair during her possession as aforesaid).
	And also I Give and Bequeath to my said Son ISAACK my Bed and Bedding as it now stands in the Hall. Also I Give and Bequeath to my Dear Daughter ELLEN my Bed and Bedding as it now stands in the Parlor. Also I Give and Bequeath to my Daughters SARAH and MARY my Bed and Bedding as it now stands in my Bed Chamber. And my Will is that the abovementioned Legacies shall be delivered to the said Legataries immediately after my Decease by my Executor.
	Also I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter SARAH the sum of Three Pounds to be paid by my said Son ISAACK three years after the Decease or Intermarriage of my Wife. Also I Give and Bequeath to my Daughter MARY the sum of Three Pounds to be paid by my Son ISAACK six years after the Decease or Intermarriage of my Wife aforesaid. But if default be made in payment of the said Legacies at the times above indicated for payment then it may be lawfull for my said Daughter or Daughters to enter upon and seize the said Messuage with the appurts till their respective Legacies be full paid and satisfied.
	Lastly I appoint my said Loving Wife ELLEN ASPLAND Sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament she paying my Debts performing my Legacies and seeing my Body decently interred. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Eighteenth day of July in the Eleventh Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord King George the second by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the Faith and so forth and in the Year of our Lord 1737.
