## WEDDING IN MOURNING:

The wedding of Henry Robert BARWICK (nephew) took place on 24th April 1895 at Filey and was reported in the local newspaper. Everyone was in mourning following the death of Mrs Ann SMITH of Cliff House, Filey. The bride was wearing grey and jet and the bridesmaids were in brown with black hats - the whole affair being quiet. The 'large number of costly presents' are enumerated at great length and reveal some of who was who in the family.

(6th May 1854)

Marriage, Thursday, April 20, at Coxwold, Mr. George SMITH of Newburgh Park to Ann, eldest daughter of the late Mr. William BARWICK, of Coxwold.

Extract from will of George Smith of Cliff House of Filey zDDX34/4 3 Aug 1885:

Bequests: wife Ann; nieces Eliza Jane Smith, Lucy Helen Barwick; nephew Henry Robert Barwick; nieces Ann Elizabeth Webb, Maud Barwick (sisters of Lucy Helen Barwick); 'but not one fraction to William Frederick Webb the husband should he ever return to his wife' Property: 'Cliff House' and 15 The Crescent Probate: 9 Oct 1886.
