OBITUARY:	
(Extract from article in Leeds Mercury, dated 15th March 1887)	
He was born near Dewsbury and the family moved to Leeds when he was 13.	
He was the Organist at St. Ann's RC Church and later at Leeds Grammar School chapel.	
He became the conductor of the Leeds Philharmonic Chorus and Bradford Festival Chorus.	
Every year he would arrange and conduct a series of concerts at the Queens Hotel, Leeds.	
James was best known as the Chorus Master for Leeds Music Festival from 1874 to 1883.	
His brother, Alfred Broughton subsequently took over as conductor and chorus master to the Leeds Philharmonic.	
Because of ill health (a chest infection) he went to South Africa in 1883 and whilst there he collected many art items with which his house in Leeds was adorned.	
He also travelled to New Zealand.	
His funeral took place at St. Matthews Church, Chapeltown, Leeds.	
(Info from Glenys Brown: After his death, the contents of his house were sold and there were so many items that the sale spanned 4 days).
