In an 1853 Court Case (details at Hull Record Office), a George HURDMAN purchased a piece of land in Myton from William TODD for œ140. The land was bounded by the estate of John PEARSON on the south side of English St and belonged to Thomas ENGLISH and Edmund BRANSTON. George HURDMAN died on 17/8/1849 and the land was siezed back by the vendors. A will was proved at York on 6/3/1850.
