My mother Alice was the youngest child of James Macaulay and Bertha Hurdman which would make your mother and me cousins. It had never dawned on me that "cousin Betty" might be a Bertha! As a child I went to 11 Craven Street with Alice but do not have any real memories of these visits. I last visited aunt Daisy in Bransholme in the late 80's. I have a vague recollection of being on Holderness Road as a boy in the 50's with Alice and meeting cousin Alan - I think he wore a white silk scarf!

Alice moved from Craven Street with Elsie to 38 Jesmond Gardens during the war [Kate, Arthur & "young Stivie" had moved to No.44 earlier]. Alice married James Gillard in 1944. Cousin Arthur's wife, Edna [Boylan] was my Godmother. I was born in 1945, an only child and I left Hull in 1965 to become a minister of religion - Officer of The Salvation Army. I married June Ruth Marriott in 1968 and we have three children: Stephen James [b.1969] Daniel Mark [b.1972] and Rebecca Ruth [B.1975]. June and I divorced in 1984.

June, Stephen & Rebecca live in Bolton. Daniel lived with me in Manchester for 5yrs while at university. He is now married to Nicola Ann Stevenson and lives in Chorley. I live in Salford.

After coming out, leaving the S.A. and divorcing, I was a local government officer until being forced to take medical retirement due to heart disease. I have been active in the Metropolitan Community Church in Manchester for 10 years and this occupies much of my time.
