The PATTERSON Family

PATTERSON was the maiden name of my maternal Grandmother, **Ada Patterson**. The earliest Patterson ancestor I have discovered was

Robert Patterson (b.circa 1801)

Robert Patterson was my GGG-Grandfather. He was born about 1801 in Hull, Yorkshire and he worked as a tailor. On 18th February 1827, he married **Frances Ridley Parker** in Cottingham, East Yorkshire. She had been born about 1804 in Manchester, Lancashire. They had 6 children:-

Tom Cross Patterson (1866-1906)

Tom Cross Patterson was my G-Grandfather. He was born in 1866 in Hull, Yorkshire, the son of **William Patterson** and **Mary Ann** (nee Shay). He worked as a fitter. In 1890, he married **Jane Ellen Lawton** in Hull. She was the daughter of **James Thomas Lawton**, a mariner, and **Zela** (nee Stead). Tom & Jane Ellen had 8 children:-

Ada Patterson (b.1890) was my Grandmother (see further details below).

Arthur Patterson (b.1895) moved to London and married lvy. In 1918, they were living at 26 Pembor Avenue, Forest Road, London, E17.

Zela Patterson (b.1898) died from convulsions at the age of 11 months.

Gladys Patterson (b.1900) remained unmarried. In her middle age, she acted as a companion for and looked after her elderly aunt, **Ada Ann**, the sister of her father, Tom Cross Patterson. In her latter years, Gladys was unable to look after herself and moved into a residential care hom on Anlaby Road in Hull. She died on 20th July 1991.

They lived at a number of different addresses. In 1890, when Ada was born, they lived at 13 Alma Terrace, Campbell Street, Hull. By 1891, they were living at 12 Goulton Street, Hessle Road. In 1895 they were at 90 Walcott Street, Hessle Road. By 1898 they were living at 5 Providence Terrace, Liverpool Street, Hessle Road and they were still living there at the time of Tom Cross Patterson's death from inflammation of the lungs on 21st Jan 1906, age 38 years. He was buried in Western Cemetary, Hull.

In 1908, Jane Ellen was living at 18 Convent Lane, Hull and was a shopkeeper. She subsequently remarried to **George Wilson** on 5th September 1909 and had two further children - Sidney Wilson and James Francis Wilson. Jane Ellen died on 27th November 1951 in Hull.

Ada Patterson (1890-1976)

Ada Patterson was my Grandmother. She was the oldest child of Tom Cross Patterson and Jane Ellen (nee Lawton) and was born at 13 Alma Terrace, Campbell Street, Hull, on 13th September 1890.

On 25th April 1915, she married **Henry Herbert Broughton** at St.Barnabus Church, Hull. At this time they were living at 19 Boynton Street, Hull. They subsequently settled at 1 Providence Grove, Hawthorn Avenue, Hull and Ada remained there for the rest of her life.

Both Henry Herbert (b.1915) and Arthur (b.1921) died as infants. Ada's husband, Henry Herbert (b.1894) died in 1934 at 40 years of age. This meant that Ada was left alone to raise her remaining two children. She got a job with British Railways, working as a cleaner on the railway carriages. When I was a young girl, I always associated Ada with the railways called her "Nana Puff-Puff" because I associated her with steam trains.

Her son, Herbert Dennis Broughton (b.1919) worked as a sail-maker. At the outbreak of World War II, he joined the Royal Artillery. Unfortunately, a ship he won on was sunk and Dennis was lost in action at sea on 3rd November 1941, shortly after his 21st birthday. Ada was clearly devastated by this. It was not until her death in 1976 that we discovered she had left Dennis' bedroom as it was at the time of his death, 35 years earlier. Even his coat was hung on the back of the door.

My mother, Jean died unexpectedly in 1966, leaving just myself as Ada's only remaining descendant. She had lost her husband and four children. In her latter years, her health deteriorated and she was confined to bed, having to rely upon visits from myself and from carers. She died on 1st September 1976 in Castle Hill Hospital and was buried with Henry Herbert in Western Cemetary, Hull.
