Indicates that he was found drowned in a ditch in Stepney Lane, Hull on 2nd October 1889. He was last seen alive about 6 hours previous.

An article in the Hull Daily Mail stated that the inquest was held at the Whittington Inn, Commercial Road on the same day that he was discovered. After considering the evidence, the jury returned a verdict of "Found Drowned".

It appears that Elias committed suicide as there is a reference to his death in the book entitled "THIS RASH ACT" (Suicide Across the Life Cycle in The Victorian City) by Victor Bailey, published by Stanford University Press, 1998 (ISBN 0804731241, 9780804731249).

On page 222 it says - Another suicide failed to get admitted [to the Asylum] in time. Elias Peachey, aged 64, a builder, was found drowned in October 1889. Said his son, "His intellect had been failing for two years since my mother's death ... He lost 6 stones in

weight during 12 months - which affected him very much". In late August, he had attempted to cut his throat, and so was removed to the Infirmary. The Infirmary surgeon stated that Peachey had been delusional and suicidal. "I insisted on his being watched by the police while in the Infirmary". He returned to his son's house, where he was watched, and while arrangements were made to take him to an asylum. He was willing and was to have gone on the day that he was found drowned.

"In Loving memory of MARY the beloved wife of ELIAS FOX PEACHEY who died Dec 8th 1887 aged 61 years, also the above ELIAS FOX PEACHEY who died Oct 2nd 1887 aged 64 years. At Rest."
