The name given in the 1881 Census is spelt incorrectly. The family name was RICARDO.

The head of the family was Francis Ricardo, and he was descended from the extremely wealthy (born Sephardic) Jewish family of 'Dutch' Jews, to which also belonged David Ricardo, the eminent economist. They all seem to have renounced their faith (David was an MP). Francis was the grandson of Abraham Ricardo and Rebecca (Delvalle) and son of Ralph Ricardo of Park Sq. London and Charlotte (Lobb) and he was the younger brother of Percy Ricardo of Bramley Park, Surrey. Louisa Jane Ricardo was daughter of Sir Thomas Erskine Perry, P.C., Member of the Council of India. Besides the daughters mentioned in the 1881 Census, there were also two sons, Wilfrid Francis Ricardo (b.1868) and Clement Stuart Ricardo (b.1870) - possibly both at school. The eldest daughter was Selina Frances Charlotte Ricardo, not Silvia as stated in Census. The country home of Francis Ricardo was at The Friary, Berks.

So, loads of money about, and, unusually, a fairly cultured family too.
